The Student Development Centre (SDC Centre)

What is the SDC?

- A place away from mainstream school
- A place of respite, time to reflect on unwise actions
- A place where solid catch up work can be completed
- A place where one-to-one session can be had
- A place where students are taught how to be rounded individuals as they develop into young adults
- A place where they learn about following instructions and boundaries, of what is correct behaviour within mainstream school
- Another area of support for all year groups
- SDC starts at 9am and finishes at 3pm/ Lunchtime is 11.30am – 12pm
- Once a student time is finished in SDC, they are put on an SDC report to report back to SDC Lead to monitor and support that student
- SDC Lead also monitors students' progress during different periods of the day (Follow-Through)
- External students from other secondary school are also sent to SDC for period of time
- SLT take turns throughout the week during lunch period to support, showing these students the seriousness of the Unit
